### **Key points**

# Grants are now available for works to historic buildings in North Kesteven

- The aim of the scheme is to preserve and enhance the historic interest of buildings and places by encouraging the sympathetic repair of historic buildings
- Grants are available for residential and commercial/retail buildings
- Grants are available for:
  - » 80% of the total cost of eligible works for Listed Buildings (to a maximum grant of £2,500)
  - » 60% of the total cost of eligible works or buildings in a Conservation Area (to a maximum grant of £1,500)
  - » 50% of the total cost of eligible works for local heritage assets on the Council's Local List, or which meet the designation criteria (to a maximum grant of £1,000)





# The following works are eligible for grant:

- Repair or restoration of original windows & doors
- Reinstatement of traditional windows & doors
- Stonework repairs and brickwork repairs/re-pointing
- Reinstatement of traditional roof coverings and rainwater goods
- Chimney repairs or rebuilding works
- Timber frame repairs
- Reinstatement of missing architectural features
- Repair/reinstatement of traditional boundary walls, railings and steps



# **Ineligible works**

Works not eligible for grant include the installation of UPVC windows and doors, damp proof treatments, cosmetic redecoration, general maintenance works and the reinstatement/replacement of non-original architectural features.
